CAPWN provides diaper support to clients in need, eliminating the need for referrals. Clients should arrive with income verification to complete necessary paperwork at the CAPWN Administration Building.

Pickup is scheduled for Tuesdays and the last Thursday, 3-5 PM, at the Administration Building.

NDB Requirements and Eligibility:

- **The child's parent/guardian must be the individual receiving diapers**
- **Families receive 60-80 (2 bundles) diapers**
- **Children may receive diapers until their 3rd birthday. (exception- the child has been diagnosed with special needs)**
- **Family verifies their income is below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.**
- **Families may only receive one supplement of diapers (60-80 diapers/2 bundles) from Nebraska Diaper Bank each month**
